The device purchased through the school will come with the necessary warranty and insurance as well. Students who do not wish to purchase a device because they already have their own devices will have to check with the school to ascertain whether the specifications of their existing devices meet the schools' requirements at this link https://go.gov.sg/stc-device-verification. To attain a Good grade for CCA, students must attain a minimum Level 1 in all four domains with any one of the following: At least Level 2 in three domains; At least Level 2 in one domain and at least Level 3 in another domain; or At least Level 4 in one domain.
