Dynamic Education Landscape Today

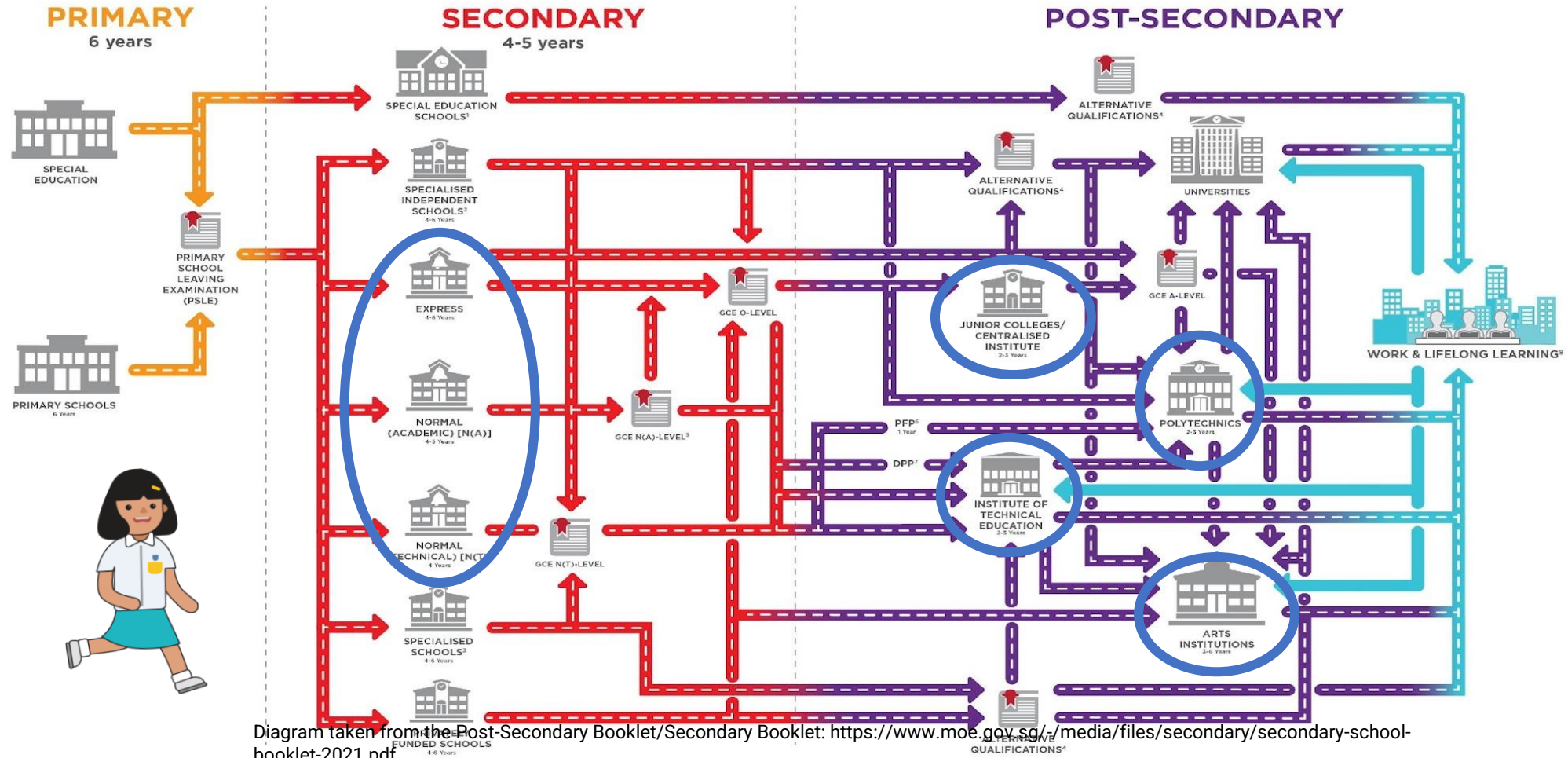

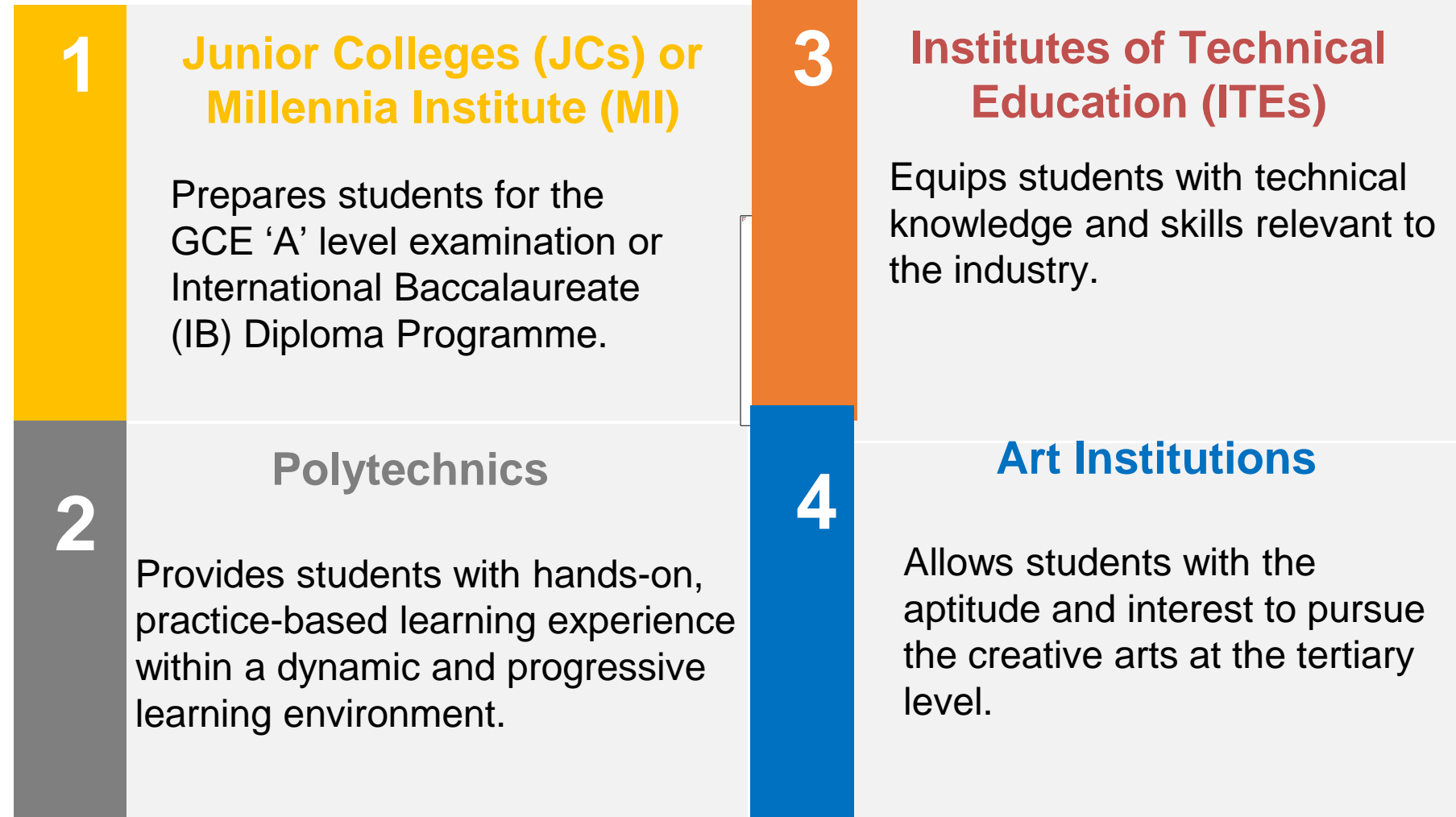

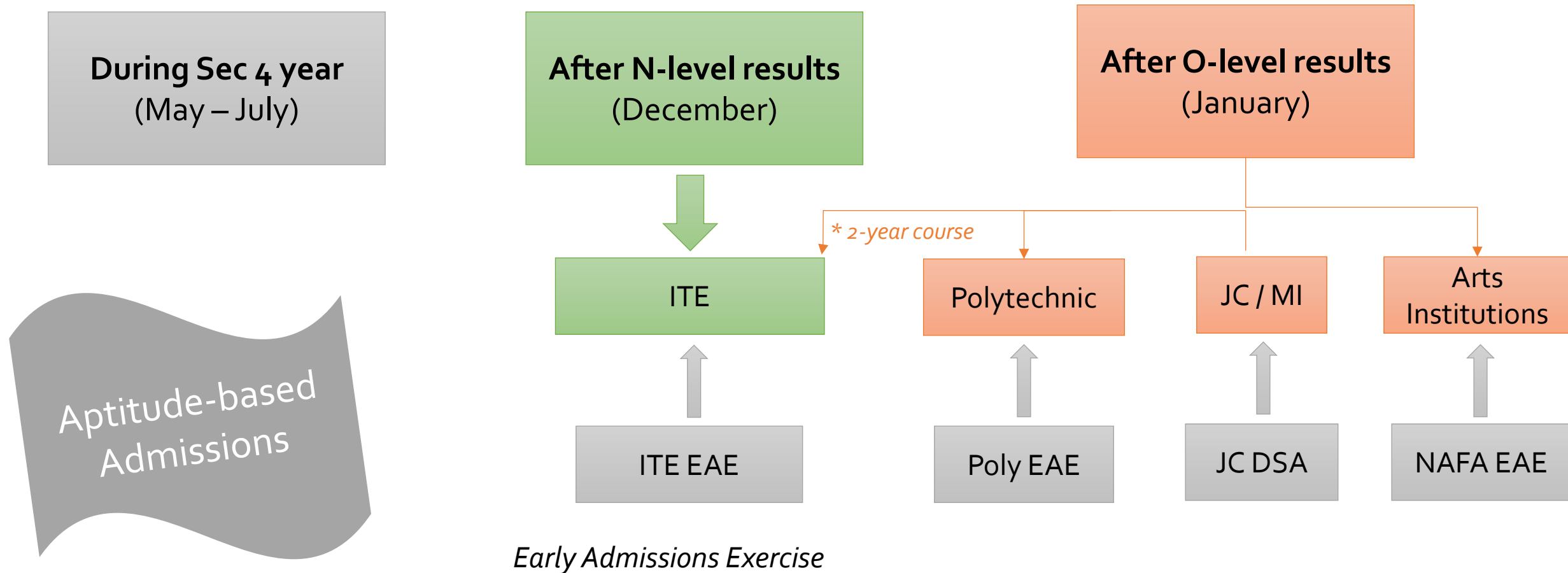

Changes to A-Level Curriculum and Autonomous University Admissions

University Admission Score

From 2026, only 3 H2 content-based subjects will count towards UAS by default.

Fourth content-based subject included only if it improves score

Project Work to be graded as a "Pass/Fail" subject

A Pass in PW still required for applications to autonomous universities.

General Paper

From 2024, all JC1 students will be required to study General Paper (GP)

[Knowledge & Inquiry (KI) de-linked, not allowed to substitute GP]

No more Mid-Year Exam

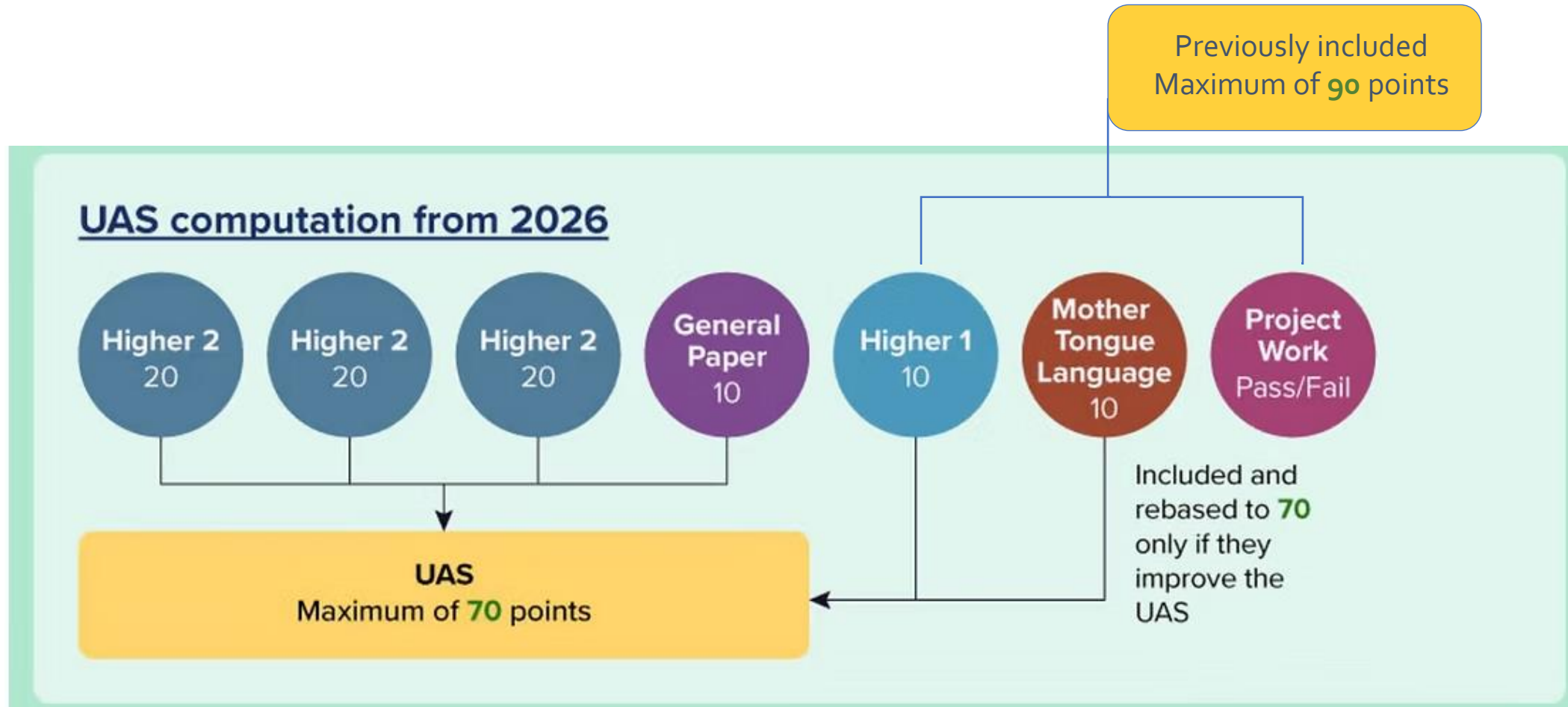

Changes to Polytechnic Pathway (PFP)

Cluster-based Programme

From 2026, students will be admitted to the PFP in **3 broad clusters*** instead of a specific diploma programme

- Sciences
- Humanities, Art, Media and Business
- Design, Engineering and Technology

* Diploma-specific admission will continue for selected specialised courses

Relaxation EL grade requirement

Grade requirement for EL standardised at Grade 3 for all clusters.

(Previously Grade 2 for Group 2 courses)

Relaxation of grade requirement for 2 'Best' subjects

Grade requirement of two 'Best' subjects in ELR2B2 relaxed from Grade 3 to Grade 4.

Changes to the ITE Pathway

Enhancement to ITE Curricular Structure

From 2026, ITE to offer only the 3-year course leading directly to a Higher Nitec certification.

This has streamlined the 2-year Nitec plus 2-year Higher Nitec structure, providing a more integrated pathway for ITE students.

ITE Progression Award (IPA)

SINGAPORE BUDGET 2024

Support for ITE graduates

For ITE graduates aged 30 and below:

Cash incentive
for eligible
WSDip trainees

- **S\$5,000 top-up** to Post-Secondary Education Account when an ITE graduate enrolls in a diploma programme
- Further **S\$10,000 top-up** to CPF Ordinary Account when the ITE graduate gets their diploma
